



## Kristupas Sabolius

Kristupas Sabolius is a **writer**, an associate professor of **philosophy** at Vilnius University (Lithuania) an ex-Fulbright fellow at Stony Brook (State University of New York). He started writing already in High school, publishing the first novel *Bad Book* in his twenties. Sabolius also collaborated with Lithuanian theatre directors and **wrote a few plays**, contemporaneously conducting a philosophical **research** on the subject of imagination. In his research, Sabolius considers imagination as the point of intersections between phenomenology, psychoanalysis, arts, cinema, theatre or even neuroscience.

He is the author of *Proteus and the Radical Imaginary* (2015, Bunkier Sztuki, in Polish and English), questioning the interconnection between reality and imagination. In 2012 he published *Furious Sleep. Imagination and Phenomenology*, a study which signalizes the contradictory function of imagination, appearing in all the major theories of Western thought, followed by *The Imaginary* (2013), a book on imagination, technology, virtuality, cinema and art.

He is also an active public intellectual and a writer of novels, theatre plays and scripts, including *The Gambler*, Lithuania's nomination for the foreign-language category at the 2015 Oscars. He teaches courses on contemporary philosophy of art and theories of imagination, co-curated a few shows (at CAC, Vilnius, and Arte Bocanera Contemporanea, Trento, Italy). Together with **Tomas Ramanaukas**, Sabolius published *The Man Who Knew It All*, a collection of 98 true stories, representing inspirational people from different backgrounds and offering a journey into the nature of creativity.
